



# 2010 MLB Pitch, Hit, & Run Competition



Aquafina Major League Baseball Pitch, Hit & Run (PHR) is an exciting skills competition that provides boys and girls the chance to advance through four levels of competition, including Team Championship events at all 30 Major League ballparks and the National Finals at the MLB All-Star Game. **New in 2010!** Beginning this year, boys and girls will have the opportunity to compete and be awarded separately.

- Where: Sgt. Jerry Mundy Memorial Park
- When: March 20, 2010
- Time: 9:00 am
- Ages: Boys & Girls 7-14 yrs old (Age is determined as of July 17, 2010)
- Age Groups: 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, & 13-14 with boys and girls competing separately

All participants **MUST** fill out a registration/waiver for obtained from the Mt. Juliet Community Center.

All participants **MUST** provide a copy of a valid birth certificate or baptismal record for age verification. **Failure to provide proof of age will result in a disqualification.**

The competition is **FREE** to all participants.

Any participant who competes in more than (1) local competition shall be disqualified.

No Metal Spikes are allowed.

There are (4) levels of competition: Local, Sectionals, Team Championships, and National Finals. National Finals will be held at the 2010 MLB All-Star Game.

Our tournament will be considered a **LOCAL TOURNAMENT**. The following participants in each age group are awarded and advance to the Sectional Competition:

\*All-Around Champion

\*\*Hitting Champion

\*\*Pitching Champion

\*\*Running Champion

\*Please keep in mind that the All-Around Champion can also be the Pitching, Hitting, and/or Running Champion.

\*\*Any competitors who tie for first place in the pitching, hitting, or running at the Local level advance to the Sectional competition (unless competitors tie for first place with the minimum score of 50 points, in which case those competitors would not advance based on that skill).
